## Museum of Applied Arts Budapest – György Ráth Villa Changes to Museum Policy and Visitor Rules

We inform our visitors that due to the current COVID-19 epidemiological situation, a body temperature check with a manual, non-contact thermometer is required before entering the premises. Visitors with a temperature of 37.5 °C or higher are not allowed to enter the museum.

## VISITOR RULES DURING THE PANDEMIC

Body temperature check with a manual, non-contact thermometer is mandatory for all visitors and museum personnel before entering the premises. The body temperature check takes no longer than 2 or 3 seconds.

In case of a temperature of 37.5 °C or higher we kindly ask our visitor(s) and museum personnel to wait outside in the garden of the György Ráth Villa for 10 minutes, after which the body temperature check may be retaken. If the temperature of the visitor(s) or the museum personnel is still 37.5 °C or higher, entry is denied.

During the entire time of the visit, it is mandatory to wear a face mask, which covers the nose and mouth properly, and to maintain at least 1.5 meters of distance from all people who do not live in your household. It is mandatory to wash your hands or use a disinfectant dispenser once you enter the premises.
